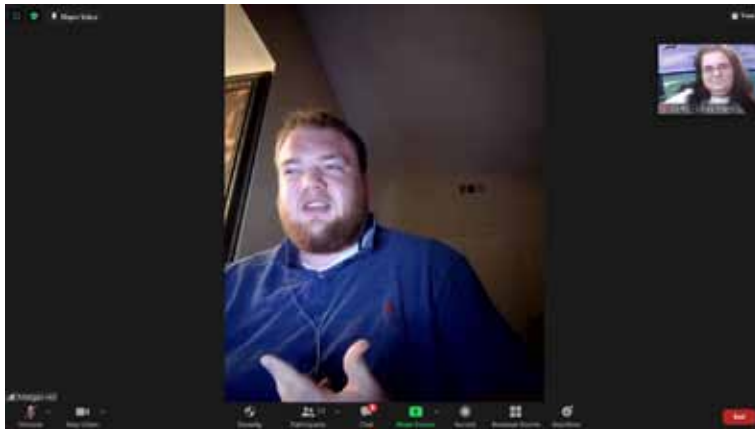
Ah Counter, who told everyone how many crutch words we all had, such as ah's and um's. Eric Varela, IP2
